This will allow a quick passage through Hell Gate and down the East River to our first night's anchorage at Liberty State Park behind the Statue of Liberty. On Monday we start the cruise in earnest up the Hudson. Ports of call may be Haverstraw Bay, Poughkeepsie, Kingston, and Catskill. Sailboats may want to bail out at Kingston while the more adventurous (i.e. power boats) continue up the Hudson past Troy to Fort Edward, New York, where they enter the Champlain Canal and the many locks to Whitehall, Vermont.
